Evidence Base - Lyn Sharratt's work, Clarity: What Matters Most in Learning, Teaching and Leading

Our initiatives include

- Provision of structured fortnightly Positive Learning Community (PLC) processes and termly planning days for staff to support a case management approach, focussed on raising the performance of every child in English.
- Engagement of school leaders in the North Coast Regional Phase 2 Leading the Learning: Developing, Using and Maintaining a whole-school approach to moderation processes.
- Developing a shared understanding of collaborative assessment of student work (CASW) incorporating walk and talks (guided by Lyn Sharratt's Clarity and What Matters Most in Learning, Teaching, and Leading).
- Allocate budget to purchase additional Teacher Aide resourcing to support targeted intervention in classrooms.
- Allocate budget to purchase interactive whiteboards to replace older smartboards.
